SBA TOURNAMENT RULES

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** open to all members of the United States Bowling Congress. Entrants must show current USBC membership card or must pay current USBC dues for an unattached membership prior to bowling. PBA MEMBERS: not more than two (2) professional members may bowl on any five (5) member team and not more than one (1) professional member may bowl in doubles.
2. **MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:** bowlers may bowl only ONE (1) time in SINGLES & DOUBLES events. Bowlers may bowl UNLIMITED times in team event, but NOT MORE THAN THREE (3) MEMBERS ON THE SAME TEAM may place more than once in the prize list for position standing. Bowler's first appearance in team event shall count toward ALL EVENTS score.
3. **PARTICIPATION:** bowlers must enter both Doubles & Singles to enter either.
4. **SCHEDULING:** entries will be scheduled based on postmark date. Entries must list 3 preferences for times and dates.
5. **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:** entry closing date is **May 1, 2012—NO EXTENSIONS**. All entries postmarked the first post office business day after the entry closing date will be accepted. Additional entries for any event will not be accepted after that date. Half (½) entries in Doubles/Singles WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. All fees must accompany the entry blank.
6. **ENTRY FEE:** entry fee is \$20.00 per bowler, per event. Entries received without ALL entry fees WILL BE RETURNED! Bowlers may choose to enter none, one, or both All Events.
7. **OPTIONAL SCRATCH EVENTS:** are an additional \$10.00 per person for each team, doubles & singles event. Optional scratch team, doubles, & singles events can only be entered if the participant is entered in the handicap event.
8. **REFUND:** there will be NO refund—team or individual—after schedule dates have been assigned.
9. **PRIZE REPORTING:** any bowler who has qualified for a prize, either cash or merchandise, of \$600 or more in any event in a tournament within the previous 12 months must report their actual score, position, and amount won to tournament management prior to bowling for possible re-rating. Such re-rating must be accomplished before the entrant bowls and, if not accepted, the entry fee shall be refunded. Failure to comply with this provision shall be cause for forfeit of entry fee and prize winnings. See USBC Rule 319d.
10. **ENTERING AVERAGE:** any valid average must consist of at least 21 games. Entrants will use highest USBC average for 2010-11 winter season in a certified league. If none, entrants will use the highest VERIFIED average as of May 1, 2012. If neither average applies, entrants will use their highest VERIFIED average in a certified 2011 summer league. Sport League Bowlers average will be adjusted by Tournament Manager based on the USBC Sport Average Adjustment Chart. All others will bowl scratch. **USBC Rule 319b, 319c, and 319d DOES APPLY.** Entrants using average other than 2010-11 season's published average must submit WRITTEN verification of average SIGNED BY League Secretary or Association Manager/Secretary.
11. **AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT:** USBC Rule 319e "Average Adjustment for Entry" will apply.
12. **AVERAGE VERIFICATION:** averages of winners will be verified prior to issuing prize monies. Claims for prize money must be made within 45 days of receipt of prize list or claims will be disallowed. Claims must be made to the SBA Executive Director.
13. **HANDICAP:** Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the bowlers entering average and 230.
14. **CHECK IN TIME:** One (1) hour prior to scheduled squad time.
15. **REPLACEMENTS/SUBSTITUTIONS:** Team Captain may make replacements/substitutions by reporting such to the tournament office at least 45 minutes prior to the scheduled bowling time. All-Events entry may be transferred **ONLY** if the transfer is made **BEFORE EITHER** of the bowlers have participated in the tournament.
16. **ORDER OF BOWLING:** teams will bowl in the order submitted on the entry form. Exceptions may be granted only by the tournament manager.
17. **BOWLERS RESPONSIBILITY:** bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average, whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain or others. If the submitted average is lower than required under rule #10 and results in more handicap, the bowler's score will be disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than required under rule #10, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average. **NO AVERAGE WILL BE VERIFIED BY TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS JUST PRIOR TO BOWLING.**
18. **PRIZE DISTRIBUTION:** prize money will be distributed at a ratio of at least one for every eight entries (1:8) in Team and Doubles & Singles handicap and scratch events. Ratio for All Events will be one for every ten entries (1:10). Plaques will be awarded to both scratch and handicap winners in each event.
19. **OFFICIAL SCORE:** the computer printout or telescore will be the official score.
20. **TARDY BOWLERS:** bowlers who miss one or more frames by not being present and ready to bowl when it is their turn, shall be credited with zero (0) pins for those frames missed.
21. **PARENTAL CONSENT:** unmarried grade or high school students who have not attained the age of 18 must have written consent of their parent or guardian in order to participate. (See USBC Rule 13)
22. **DISPUTES:** the tournament site-manager will resolve any disputes based on tournament rules.
23. **TOURNAMENT ATTIRE:** approved attire includes shirts with sleeves, slacks, dress jeans, shorts, and skorts. The following are not allowed: tank tops, short-shorts, swim suits, spandex, and hats. All decisions of proper attire will remain with the tournament manager.
24. **TOURNAMENT MANAGER has the right to add dates and times as deemed necessary.**
25. **USBC rules shall govern any rules not covered here.**
